Danica Hoffart - Musical Theatre



Dr. Danica Hoffart is a singer, conductor, musical director, educator, and adjudicator. She currently directs the Ross Street Singers in Red Deer, AB and is a vocalist with the Central Alberta Chamber Orchestra. For over two decades, Danica taught post-secondary Music and Theatre including private voice lessons, choir, singing for the stage, music history, and ear training. She has performed with Kompany! Dance and has been a soprano soloist with the Red Deer Symphony Orchestra. Select musical directing credits include *South Pacific*, *Footloose*, *Cabaret*, *The Sound of Music*, and *The Wizard of Oz*. Danica holds a Bachelor of Music and a Master of Arts in Music from the University of Alberta, and a PhD in Music from the University of Calgary. Her research examined best practices in leadership and the empowerment of individuals through participation in choir.

Angela Siemens- Choir



Angela Siemens holds a Bachelor of Arts in Music and a Bachelor of Music from Augustana University College. She continued her studies at the Victoria Conservatory of Music, where she played leading roles in Opera Studio's productions of *Brother XII* and *Romeo and Juliet*. She also holds a Voice Teacher's ARCT from the Royal Conservatory of Music and earned her Student Certificate in Yodelology. Recently, she was delighted to play the role of Coco's sister in the world premiere of *It's Coco!*—a musical fusion opera written by Cheryl Cooney and Anna Maria Kaufmann. Mrs. Siemens enjoys performing, adjudicating, and teaching. She has a thirst for knowledge and a keen interest in the science of vocal pedagogy and its applications. Her students have earned numerous scholarships and awards, but more importantly, have cultivated a deep appreciation for music and a love of singing. She believes that music is an important part of life and strives to share her joy of music with everyone she works with. She currently teaches from her private studio in Red Deer and loves working with her choir, The Inglewood Sunshine Choir.

Janna Olson - Intermediate Piano



Originally from Three Hills, Alberta, Janna Olson holds degrees in church music, piano performance and piano pedagogy. Performing, adjudicating, and giving workshops have provided diverse opportunities for her to share her love of music in Canada, the United States and Europe. Janna currently resides in Edmonton teaching privately and as a sessional instructor at The King's University. She is active as an examiner and clinician while maintaining a thriving private piano studio which includes students from ages 5-70+ years old. She is on the faculty of the Gordon Institute for Music Learning and is passionate about connecting piano pedagogy with research on how the musical mind works. She enjoys playing chamber music and performs piano duet and duo repertoire. An

outdoors enthusiast, Janna spends time hiking, skiing and most recently learning to play disc golf.

Jani Parsons - Senior Piano & Piano Plan I



Praised for her “combination of tenderness and vivacious energy” (San Francisco Chronical) and “sheer virtuosity” (LA Splash), Canadian pianist and chamber musician Jani Parsons has established herself as a musician of warmth, brilliance, versatility, and vivid expression and a vibrant and inspiring teacher. Jani is a founding member and executive director of Latitude 49 and co-author of “Technique Through Repertoire” published through Piano Education Press. She was recently appointed Assistant Professor of Piano and head of the piano program at the University of Calgary in 2021.

Jani holds a Doctoral degree in Piano Performance and Pedagogy from the University of Michigan, studying with Dr. Arthur Greene and Dr. John Ellis. As an avid performer and supporter of living composers, Jani has worked directly with many composers to premiere upwards of eighty new solo and chamber works and has appeared in 10 professionally released records. Past performances include appearances at the Chan Centre for the Arts, the Banff Centre for the Arts, Detroit Symphony Center, the Ravinia Festival and the Museum of Contemporary Art (Chicago). Her infectious energy for educating young musicians has led to positions at Baylor University and residencies at Princeton University, the New England Conservatory, Indiana University, and Northwestern University among others.

Arlene Irwin - Speech



Arlene brings more than 35 years of stage experience to her role as Speech Arts & Drama Instructor on the teaching faculty at Mount Royal University Conservatory. A native of Northern Ireland, she has been studying Speech Arts and Drama since the age of 14. Throughout the years, not only has she won numerous speech and drama awards, but also continues to be an active theatre performer. Arlene's most recent roles were as "Mother Superior" in Storybook Theatre's musical production of "Sister Act" and in 2022, the role of "Irene Ruddock" in Alan Bennett's "A Lady of Letters" for which she received the award of outstanding performer at the Calgary One Act Festival.

Arlene holds accreditations through Trinity College London as an Associate & Licentiate in Speech Arts and Drama as well as the ARCT Teacher's designation. She is also an RCM registered teacher. Although teaching full time at the Conservatory, Arlene operates a small private studio and has adjudicated at numerous Speech Arts Festivals including The Kelowna Kiwanis Music Festival, MedicineHat, Airdrie, and Lethbridge. She has also had the pleasure of working with Autism Calgary and the Autism/Asperger's Friendship Society teaching drama and social skills to a variety of enthusiastic students on the Autism spectrum. Arlene's continued passion is to impart her Speech Arts knowledge and skills to students in the Mount Royal University Conservatory program where she provides both private and group instruction.

Joy Berg- Voice



Professor Emeritus (from Concordia University of Edmonton), Dr. Berg is delighted to now be living in the Camrose community, continuing to be a sessional instructor at The King's University as well as at Augustana. Joy sang for 16 years as an Alto with Procoro Canada (Edmonton's professional choir), and is the curator for the Cypress Publishing church choir series, Songs for the Sanctuary. She holds a Doctorate of Music degree in Choral Conducting as well as a Doctorate of

Worship Arts. Joy started her business, Sanctuary Sounds, which includes the Camrose community choirs of Ubuntu:Collective. Joy also enjoys her continuing role in conducting The Kings Community and Alumni Chorus throughout the year.

Maryan Threndyle - Junior Piano



Maryan Threndyle has a Master of Music degree in piano performance from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. She completed undergraduate degrees in music and education at Mount Allison University in Sackville New Brunswick.

With an active piano studio in St. Albert since 1983, Maryan has taught at all levels from beginner to ARCT. Her students have often received festival awards and other scholarships. For 13 years she was a teacher with the Yamaha Junior Music Program in Edmonton. She is inspired by adjudicating at music festivals around the province and is looking forward to hearing your performance!

From 2003-17 Maryan was Festival Coordinator of the St. Albert Rotary Music Festival. This community service led to being recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow by Rotary International in 2008 and 2012. A strong supporter of the festival movement in Alberta and across the country, she is thrilled to be invited to the Highwood Lions Music Festival. Through the years, Maryan has valued the opportunity to sing with the Richard Eaton Singers, Edmonton's symphonic choir and Kappella Kyrie, Slavic Chamber Choir.

Brett Gunther- Guitar



Brett Gunther has been serving on the board of governors for the Classical Guitar Society of Calgary as the artistic director since June 2010, and director for the Classical GuitarFest West guitar festival since 2015. He is currently on the faculty at Mount Royal University Conservatory teaching private lessons as well as ensemble classes for the Academy program. Brett is in high demand as an adjudicator for festivals across Canada and is an examiner for the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto.

Brett's debut CD, *Guitar Music*, released in 2012, examines the music of some of the most significant composers for the guitar in the 20th century. Included are works by Rodrigo, Britten, Barrios, Brouwer, Tarrega, and Domeniconi. His most recent release, *An Idea* (2017), explores selections of some of his favorite composers from the 18th, 19th, and 20th centuries featuring works by Schubert, Mertz, Legnani, Moreno-Torroba, Bach, Brouwer, and Giuliani.

Craig Johnson- Bands, Woodwinds/Brass/Percussion



Originally from Winnipeg MB, Craig studied privately with a long list of classical and jazz instructors on his primary instruments (Trumpet & Piano). After highschool he attended The University of Manitoba furthering his studies in the Performing Fine Arts Program. He went on to study Jazz Arranging, Orchestral Composition, and Writing for Motion Picture and TV earning his General Music Studies degree at The Berklee College of Music in Boston. Now living in Calgary with over 30 years of teaching and performing experience Craig remains an active clinician, teaching within the Calgary Board of Education and private sector band music programs. He maintains a large private student base, and has had a number of students go on to pursue their own musical careers at the professional level.

In 2003 Craig accepted the position of Musical Director for a Calgary based big band association followed by a second offer in 2019 from an additional association. His roles include, directing, writing and arranging a large portion of the band's repertoire for performance. In addition to teaching and adjudicating music festivals throughout Alberta, as a band leader he leads his own groups of various sizes and has been commissioned by different organizations and independent artists to write music for their specific recording and or performing projects. Currently Craig is creating a self published music company under the name MAXALBY Music Publishing, making available his original works and arrangements for Jazz Ensemble, Concert Band, Orchestra, and various small group ensembles ranging from beginner to advanced to professional levels.



Jeff Plotnick- Strings

Jeff Plotnick retired after more than 30 years as Principal 2nd violin of the Calgary Philharmonic Orchestra. He also served as Concertmaster of the Festival Choral and Bach Society Orchestras and was a frequent violin soloist with these ensembles.

He has been on the Faculty of the University of Calgary, Mount Royal College and Amici String Program in Calgary; and has been in demand as a string adjudicator throughout Western Canada.

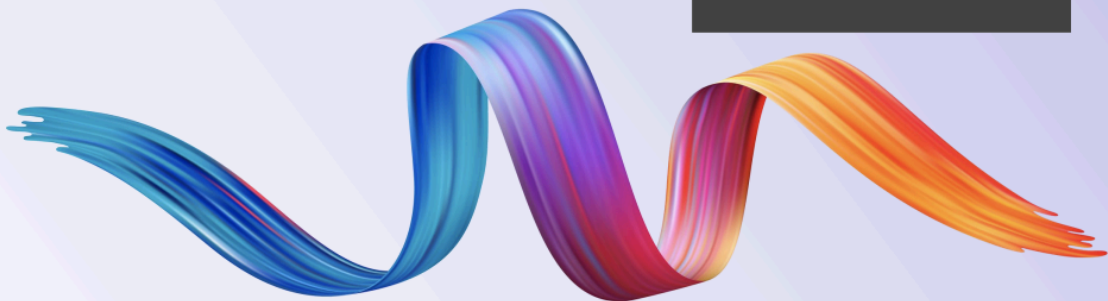
