

2022 FESTIVAL IN PERSON ADJUDICATION SESSION GUIDE

How to find out when your adjudication session will take place:

There are two ways to find out when your adjudication will take place.

- 1. Login to your account with our festival here.
- 2. Check our online 'program' which is located on the front page of our website (www.highwoodmusicfestival.com).

How to prepare for your adjudication session:

- All live adjudication sessions will take place at the High River United Church (123 Macleod Trail SW, High River).
- Ensure you have an original copy of your music with you. Photocopies will not be permitted. If your music was purchased online, proof of purchase must be provided.
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of your adjudication session.
- Check in with our volunteers at the registration table. They will collect your music and mark that
 you have arrived. When the session before yours is complete, you can enter the venue and wait
 for your group to start.

What will happen during your adjudication session

- When it is your turn, you will be introduced by the secretary. You'll perform your piece and then wait for the rest of the group to perform.
- After everyone has performed, the adjudicator will interact with each of you. They may get you to perform selections of your piece. This will be almost like a 'mini-lesson'. Enjoy learning from their wealth of knowledge!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Can I reschedule my adjudication session?

Because we are working with a large amount of entrants and as well as the schedules of our adjudicators, we are unable to accommodate schedule changes. We hope that the fact that the adjudication session will take place online will help as you can access them from a variety of places!

Can friends or family members watch the adjudication sessions?

Absolutely! You're welcome to invite friends or family to watch your performance. There are no restrictions in place, but space for social distancing will be provided.
